

## **Title: Clinical Risk Assessments**

**Aims:** To develop participants skills and confidence in completing clinical risk assessments utilizing the Sainsbury risk assessment model.

Develop and practice completing the risk assessment tool  
Understand the importance of clinical risk assessments  
Sharing good practice at work

### **Target Audience:**

This course is designed for anyone who may be required to complete clinical risk assessments in their working environment. It will increase participant's awareness and confidence levels and enable them to more effectively complete and understand the clinical risk assessment process at work.
